## ELIGIBILITY

## CAMPING OPTIONS

#### **RESIDENT CAMPER**

Students stay on campus 24/7 through the duration of camp in one of our campus dormitories. All meals are included for residential campers.

#### **COMMUTER CAMPER**

Students attend all daily musical activities but are free to go home at the end of the day. They may participate in any and all activities, but cannot spend the night. Lunch is the only meal offered to commuter

## MEALS

Meals are served at the Fresh Food Company in the EKU dining hall, where many nutritious and exciting options are available in an *all-you-can-eat buffet* style.

## FACULTY
